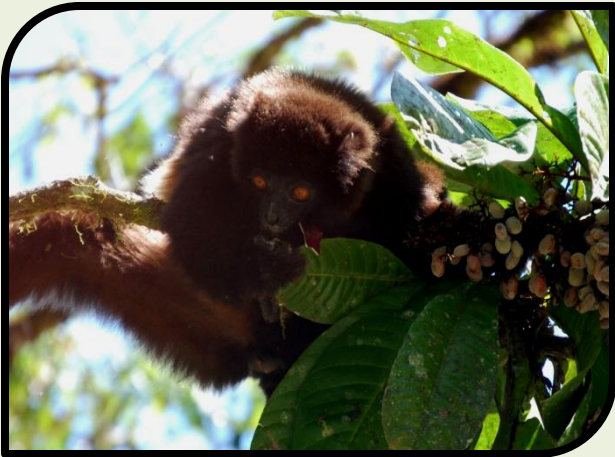




# Study Abroad In Madagascar
